**AMENDED ADDITIONAL
ORDER ON PRELIMINARY
APPROVAL**

1 Plaintiffs filed their motion for preliminary approval of the proposed
2 settlement on August 12, 2019. On September 11, 2019 the Court issued a tentative
3 ruling. A hearing was held on the tentative ruling on September 16, 2019.


4 At the hearing, the parties addressed the Court’s concern about the release
5 language in paragraph IX.A of the Settlement Agreement. The parties have
6 conferred and have agreed to add the clarification language: “The Release by
7 members of the Settlement Class is not a general release” to that paragraph.

8 Subject to that addition, and in addition to the reasons discussed in the
9 Court’s Order of September 16, 2019, the Courts sets the following schedule:

- 10 a. Younique shall transfer \$200,000 into the Settlement Fund no later than
11 October 31, 2019.
- 12 b. The Settlement Administrator shall cause the Notice Plan to commence
13 no later than October 23, 2019.
- 14 c. Plaintiffs shall file their Motion for Attorneys’ Fees, Costs, and
15 Expenses, and Motion for Service Award by no later than November
16 18, 2019.
- 17 d. Settlement Class Members who wish to object must file any objections
18 to the Settlement by no later than January 21, 2020.
- 19 e. Settlement Class Members who wish to exclude themselves must
20 exclude themselves, or opt-out, from the Settlement by no later than
21 January 21, 2020.
- 22 f. Settlement Class members who wish to submit claims must submit
23 claims by no later than January 21, 2020.
- 24 g. Plaintiffs shall file their Motion for Final Approval of the Settlement by
25 no later than March 6, 2020.
- 26 h. Settlement Class Members who intend to appear at the Final Fairness
27 Hearing must file a Notice of Intention to Appear at the Final Fairness
28 Hearing by no later than March 20, 2020.

- 1 i. The Settlement Administrator shall file a declaration or affidavit with
- 2 the Court that confirms the implementation of the Notice Plan pursuant
- 3 to the Preliminary Approval Order by no later than March 27, 2020.
- 4 j. Class Counsel and Defendant’s Counsel shall have the right to respond
- 5 to any objection by no later than March 30, 2020.
- 6 k. The Fairness Hearing will take place on April 6, 2020 at 1:30 p.m. at
- 7 the United States District Court for the Central District of California,
- 8 Southern Division, in Courtroom 10C.
- 9 l. Within 10 bank days of the Effective Date (as that term is defined in
- 10 the Settlement Agreement) of the Class Settlement Agreement,
- 11 Younique shall fund \$3,050,000.00 into the Settlement Fund.
